SOLDIERS TO SCHOLARS LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

Soldiers to Scholars is a program administered by the Defense Transition Services/ University of Central Florida; funded by the State of Florida and the Florida Housing Finance Corporation (FHFC).

To maintain your eligibility in the program you will be required to:

- Be enrolled at UCF, Valencia College, or Seminole State College
- Complete a minimum of 24 credit hours per year for undergrad students, and 15 credit hours per year, for graduate students
- Maintain required GPA of 2.5 for undergraduate students and 3.0 for graduate students
- Dedicate at least 2 separate days to the WSB and perform a minimum of 7 service hours per week. Saturday programs may not be substituted for normal walking days
- Attendance is ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY [In addition to 10 service hours but not in lieu of for all monthly meetings, specified training(s), and quarterly health fair(s). Designed to aid you in working with at-risk youth.
- Reside in authorized complexes unless an Associate member*

- Do not exceed household income limits specified by FHFC (housing recipients)
- In keeping with the standards, participants may live with immediate family members or same sex participants
- *Associate members receive only tuition assistance and must provide the required 10 service hours per week, complete 24 credit hours per year and maintain required GPA

Failure to meet the above requirements 2 times per school year, without sufficient justification, will result in withdrawal from the program.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES FOR STS WALKING SCHOOL BUS

***MAINTAIN A VISUAL, ACCURATE COUNT OF STUDENTS, BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER REACHING THEIR DESTINATION. STUDENTS THAT ALLOWED TO GO TOO FAR AHEAD OF THE LEAD PARTICIPANT OR DRIFT BEHIND THE TRAILING PARTICIPANT ARE AT RISK OF BEING ABDUCTED. (KEEP WATCHFUL EYES).

- 1. PRIOR TO THE AM & PM WSB, PARTICIPANTS MUST MEET ATTHE STS OFFICE FOR UPDATE ON PROBLEMS OF THE DAY.
- 2. THE DESIRED RATIO FOR THE WSB IS ONE STS PARTICIPANT FOR EVERY TEN (10) STUDENTS MINIMUM.
- 3. REFLECTIVE VEST MUST BE DISTRIBUTED TO STUDENTS DURING THE MORNING WSB
- 4. PARTICIPANTS MUST ENSURE THAT A COPY OF THE SIGN IN ROSTER, THE FIRST AID KIT, AND BACKPACK IS CARRIED ON EACH WALK.
- 5. STS PARTICIPANTS MUST POSITION THEMSELVES EVENLY THROUGHOUT THE WALKING FORMATION FOR MAXIMUM VISUAL AND VOICE SUPERVISION.
- 6. DISCOURAGE STUDENTS FROM PICKING UP FOREIGN OBJECTS (STICKS, BOITLES, PAPER OR OTHER OBJECTS THAT MAY CAUSE INJURY OR SICKNESS.
- 7. PARTICIPANTS SHOULD DISCOURAGE STUDENTS FROM MAKING NEGATIVE VERBAL COMMENTS ABOUT OTHER STUDENTS, STUDENT'S PARENTS, SEXUAL ORIENTATION AND TEASING TO OFFEND SOMEONE.
- 8. WARN STUDENTS TO REFRAIN FROM RUNNING, HITTING, SLAPPING OR KICKING OTHER STUDENTS.
- 9. STS PARTICIPANTS MUST INSURE THAT THERE ARE 2 LINES AT ALL TIMES. LINES MUST STAY INTACT AND AS CLOSE AS POSSIBLE FOR MAXIMUM SUPERVISION (ESPECIALLY DURING STREET CROSSINGS). REMIND STUDENTS TO STAY INSIDE THE CROSSWALK WHEN CROSSING THE STREET. WALK QUICKLY BUT DO NOT RUN.



- 10. DO NOT ALLOW STUDENTS TO WALK OR RUN WITH SHARP OBJECTS SUCH AS PENCILS, RULERS, STICKS, ETC. THESE COULD CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR EVEN DEATH.
- 11. AT CROSS WALKS, ATLEAST 1 PARTICIPANT WILL BE POSTED ACROSS THE STREET TO BLOCK IMCOMING TRAFFIC. ANOTHER PARTICPANT BLOCKING OUTGOING TRAFFIC. THE REMAINING PARTICIPANTS (1 IN FRONT, 1 IN REAR) WILL WALK ALONGSIDE THE OUTSIDE LINE CLOSEST TO TRAFFIC.
- 12. SNACKS ARE NOT PERMITTED DURING THE WALK. HOWEVER, STUDENTS MAY CARRY A BOTTLE OF WATER.
- 13. STUDENTS MAY ONLY BE PICKED UP FROM AUTHORIZED PICKUP SITES. EAGLES NEST ELEMENTARY, ISLAND CLUB AND THE STS CENTER, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF STUDENTS JOINING THE WSB FROM NEIGHBORING COMPLEXES.
- 14. STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONICS ON THE WSB. PARTICIPANTS MAY ONLY USE PHONES AS IT PERTAINS TO THE WSB.
- 15. IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY NOTIFY IMMEDIATE SUPERVISORS AND THE PROPER AUTHORITIES IF NEEDED.
- 16. PARTICIPANTS DIMISSALS WILL BE DICTATED OFF OF STUDENT/ PARTICIPANT RATIOS.
- 17. ALL COMMON AREAS MUST BE CLEANED AND SECURED AT ALL TIMES.
- 18. STS PARTICIPANTS SHOULD ALWAYS BE MINDFUL TO MAKE SURE STUDENTS DO NOT RUN AWAY OR WANDER OFF.
- 19. ALL NEGATIVE INCIDENTS AND ACCIDENTS MUST BE DOCUMENTED AND REPORTED TO THE APPROPRIATE AUTHORITY.
- 20. SHIFT ROLES SHOULD BE ASSIGNED DAILY (PACER, 2 ROAD GUARDS, COMS/MEDIC).
- 21. REPORT FOR DUTY ON TIME.

UCF SOLDIERS TO SCHOLARS HONORING THE COMMITMENT

As a veteran or active duty military personnel, it is imperative that you honor the commitment made by you with Soldiers to Scholars (STS). The University of Central Florida (UCF)/STS will honor its commitment in providing educational assistance in exchange for you meeting all the above requirements. Failure to meet all obligations of the STS program will constitute a breach of the agreement. Therefore, UCF/STS would have the right to terminate the participant from the program and discontinue all assistance.


